Mind

Romans 7:13—25

V. 23 But I see another law in my members warring against the law of my **mind**, and bringing me into captivity to the law of sin which is in my members. O wretched man that I am! Who will deliver me from this body of death? I thank God—through Jesus Christ our Lord! So then, **with the mind** I myself serve the law of God, but with the flesh the law of sin. Revelation 12:10

Then I heard a voice saying in heaven, now salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of His Christ have come, for the **accuser** of our brethren, who **accused** them before our God day and

Heart

Matthew 15:16—20

So Jesus said: Are you also still without understanding? Do you not yet understand that whatever enters the mouth goes into the stomach and is eliminated? But those things which proceed out of the mouth come from the **heart**, and they defile a man. For out of the **heart** proceed evil thoughts, murders, adulteries, fornications, thefts, false witness, blasphemies.

Acts 5:3

But Peter said to Ananias, why has Satan filled your **heart** to lie to the Holy Spirit and keep back part of the price of the land for yourself?

Guilt / Depression

1 John 3:20 & 21

For if our heart **condemns** us, God is greater than our heart, and knows all things. If our heart does not **condemn** us, we have confidence toward God. **Samuel 16**—Saul possessed by an evil spirit (**depression**).

Singing & Praise

1 Samuel 16
1 Samuel 30

David sings and plays music to set Saul free from a depressing spirit.
David at Ziklag faced death from his men. He worshiped & God answered.

Acts 16 Paul & Silas in a dungeon **sang & praised** God and an earth-quake shook the jail and opened the doors.
Psalm 100 We come before God's presence with **singing**, we enter His gates with **thanksgiving**, and into His courts with **praise**.
Psalm 22:3 But You (God) are holy, enthroned in the praises of Israel (& believers).

Destroyer

John 10:10 The thief does not come but to steal, and to kill, and to **destroy**.
1 Corinthians 10:10 Nor complain, as some of them also complained, and were **destroyed** by the destroyer.

Body

1 Corinthians 5:5 Deliver such a one to Satan for the **destruction of the flesh**, that his spirit may be saved in the day of the Lord Jesus.
2 Corinthians 12:7 And lest I be exalted above measure by the abundance of the revelations, a **thorn in the flesh** was given to me, a **messenger of Satan** to buffet me, lest I be exalted above measure.

Disease & Pain

Acts 10:38 How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and **healing all** who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him. (also **2 Cor. 12:7** above)

Resist / Bind / Authority

James 4:7 Therefore submit to God. **Resist** the devil and he will flee from you.
Matthew 16:19 And I will give you the keys (authority) to the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you **bind** on earth shall be bound in heaven, and whatever you **loose** on earth will be loosed in heaven.
Luke 10:19 Behold, I give you the **authority** to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
